CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Please send an **age appropriate, non-glamorized** picture by March 30, 2010. (School pictures are great!) Please send wallet size **ONLY**.

The Princess is required to wear a white party or semi-formal dress in the evening gown production number. It must be all white (a small amount of colored trim is allowable) and be no longer than mid-calf length. White shoes and anklet socks are suitable for younger girls. Clear shoes or “age appropriate” sandals are okay for the older girls. Please choose clothing carefully, keeping in mind the age of your child.

No make-up may be used for the younger girls and age appropriate for the older girls. The pageant officials reserve the right to make suggestions or rejections on all clothing & make-up or anything affecting the princess appearance. This is not a competition, so we suggest a natural look.

The Princesses will also perform a production number on stage Friday. After the Princess is given her crown, please label the elastic on the crown with her name.
